

What's New with Version 2.0

The following is a list of changes and new features with NEware V2.0. For more information, please refer to NEware's Online Help.

- · Online Help for quick reference and step-by-step instructions
- Grafica Graphic LCD Keypad section where users can:
 - Create and download up to 32 floor plans, 8 special event images and 1 logo
 - Download up to 15 system tones
 - Create and download up to 8 special event messages complete with images, tones and text
- Search Events feature allows users to quickly search the Live and Stored System Event lists using detailed criteria
- Print the user code and event lists directly from the grid without having to create a report first
- Quickly filter the Live and Stored System Event lists for one condition only using NEware's Quick Event Filtering feature
- Improved event filtering dialog box for quicker criterion selection
- Live Events Backup Reminder feature notifies a user of when to backup the Live Events list when it has reached a predefined number of events
- Assigned access cards are now immediately detected by NEware and the card's serial number is automatically placed in the Stored Access Card list

- Set separate Door Unlocked Schedules for every access control door in the system
- Unlock doors manually regardless of the door's unlocked schedule
- Transfer programming from the PC to the control panel as well as from the control panel to the PC as was previously available
- NEware's redesigned logon screen and logon procedure improves usability and user control
- All features are now accessible in menus via NEware's menu bar
- System Monitoring is now always enabled while in online mode so alarm and trouble messages will always appear
- · Arm/Disarm all areas assigned to a user at the same time
- Automatically verify the Paradox Web site for NEware updates
- · Lock NEware until a valid code # (PIN) is entered
- Backup and Restore feature for both NEware and Grafica programming
